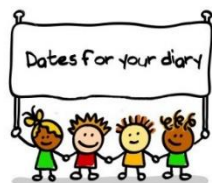

Dear Parents/Carers

This half term our topic is The World Around Us and the question we are asking is: How can we help the World around us? We start by learning about different ways that we can look after the world. We then move onto learning about London and the buses and tubes. Finally, we compare our environment in Ruislip Manor to that of a rainforest.



Tube Trip: We are hoping to take the children on the London Underground from Ruislip Manor to Uxbridge and back as part of looking at their own environment. The dates are:
