Reminder: Please ensure that your child's belongings are clearly labelled as the written names can fade with time.

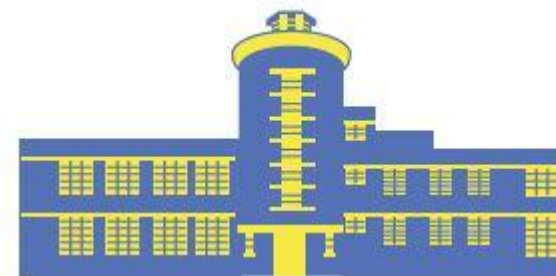

Dear families and Nursery children,

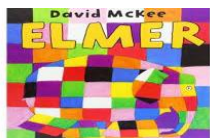
Our new topic this half term is 'Celebrating Colour'. The key question is 'What colours can you see?' So far, the children have been learning about...

Nursery home learning:

- To draw a picture using their favourite colour
