Spellings

Every week the children will have a spelling test and will receive a set of spellings they are to learn for the following week. In their spelling books, the children will need to complete the grid and underneath write **at least** 5 sentences using the words from their list (they can write more sentences if they wish).

Please use the QR code to find the statutory word list for Year 3 and 4 (page 16). These are words frequently used and often misspelled in pupils' writing. When we moderate the children's writing, we check that these words are written correctly.

We have already started booking trips and visits for this year. In the Autumn term we will be visiting Chiltern Open Air Museum, here the children will take part in several workshops, visit the Museum gallery and the Park grounds.
