## BEHAVIOUR STATEMENT

The school has three specific, simple rules for the playground and five for the school as a whole. These rules encourage positive behaviour and are known by all the school community. They help to keep everyone in the school community safe and ensure that the children can learn to the best of their ability.

- *No contact*

### Rewards and sanctions- a quick guide

Positive reinforcement of good behaviour is embedded across the school through the use of house points and merit awards. The Headteacher and Assistant Headteachers have prize boxes for children who have shown them excellent learning.

If a child does not follow any of the school or playground rules they will be asked to spend some time reflecting on their behaviour or completing any learning that the teacher may require them to do.
