



Year One Home Learning Tasks – Autumn 1

1. Look at a photograph from when you were younger. How have you changed? Can you draw two different things you did then and two things that you can do now?
2. Talk about the toys your family played with in the past. Can you design your own toy at home?
3. Talk to someone at home about what you would like to do when you grow up. Try to find out a little bit more about it by talking to people who know about that role or looking in a book or on the internet with a grown up. Then, you can share what you have found out with the class.
 4. Use some paint to make handprints of everyone's hands in your family and then cut out the handprints. Can you put them in order of size from the smallest handprint to the largest handprint? If you don't have any paint, you could draw around hands instead!
5. We have been looking at the five senses in our lessons. Explore the sense of taste by making a healthy dish with your grown up at home. Can you show your friends in class a photograph of your healthy dish?
