



Year Two Home Learning Tasks – Autumn Term

1. Our topic this term is the Great Fire of London! We would like your child to do some research on this. Can they make an old fashioned building surrounded in flames, or create a poster of facts, maybe even a timeline of the events of that night?
2. In English we have been looking at the short story 'Oliver's Vegetables'. We would like your child to create a healthy vegetable or fruit dish just like Oliver does in the story and send us in a photo!
3. In Art we are using our pencil line drawing skills. We would like your child to create a picture of the Great Fire of London using shading only. Perhaps they would like to do one building in detail or they can do an entire scene from the event.
4. Samuel Pepys is a very important figure in the Great Fire of London event. Can your child write a fact file all about him? Explaining why he was so important?
5. In Science we are looking at Materials, can your child walk around the home and start grouping objects they find into the materials they are made from? Perhaps they could describe some of their properties too (E.g. What they feel/look like – smooth, rough, shiny etc.)
6. In DT, we will be making a Christmas decoration made from felt. We would like your child to design and make a Christmas decoration at home, but using a different material such as paper, card etc.
7. As the children move towards Christmas, we will begin to introduce cursive handwriting to them. Please support your child in practising their Cursive handwriting using the Sky Writer app below. <https://ictgames.com/mobilePage/skyWriter/index.html>
8. In Geography, the children will be recapping their knowledge of Human and Physical features. We would like your child to go on a 'Geography Walk' and identify Physical features (natural, such as trees, flowers etc) and Human features (made by humans, such as post office, roads, restaurants).
