Spring Term

- Design an Anglo-Saxon outfit.
- Make a model of an Anglo-Saxon home.
- Write a menu for an Anglo-Saxon feast.
- Identify Anglo-Saxon place names on a map of the UK.
- Design a set of Anglo-Saxon armour and shield.
- Find out about Anglo Saxon Runes and write a coded message for your class to decipher.
- Draw and describe an Anglo-Saxon god or goddess.
- Devise a quiz about Anglo Saxons.
- Draw and label an Anglo Saxon settlement.
- Research and write a fact file or Power Point about the Sutton Hoo treasure.
- Build your own longhouse model: Think about the features of a longhouse (the fire in the middle, a thatched roof, and benches with animal skins) and try to create a miniature version. Choose your materials carefully!
- Create a leaflet about an aspect of Viking life (e.g. travel, lifestyle, communication).
- Create a Viking collage of an interesting Viking scene – here are some ideas to help you:
 - A longboat on a stormy sea
 - A Viking farm
 - A Viking raid!
- Write your own story set in Viking times. Remember to include exciting descriptions and lots of clues that the story is set in Viking times.
- Write a recipe for Viking bread; include photos of your own creation!
- Design a dragonhead to go on the prow of a Viking Longboat.
- Design and make the best dragon's eye ever! What will you use?
